
ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP - HLS PERMISSIVE ACCESS

This network of permissive bridleways and footpaths is provided by the Trumpington Farm Company with Natural England's support. Walkers, cyclists and horse riders are free to use these routes, linking to local landmarks such as Grantchester meadows and the Bourn Brook. Venturing further south west across the motorway bridges leads to an additional permissive bridleway adjacent to Cambridge University's array of travelling Radio telescopes.



This access is provided under the Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs' farm conservation schemes as managed by Natural England, helping farmers and land managers protect and improve the countryside, its wildlife and history. It is permissive access and no new rights of way are being created. Existing rights of way are not affected. Please follow the Country Code & local signs. CRoW Open Access is provided under the CRoW Act 2000 and gives rights of access to open country (For details & restrictions see https://www.gov.uk/right-of-way-open-access-land/overview). Do not disturb wildlife, livestock or other visitors and in particular keep dogs under control. This is working farmland so please take care. People using this site do so at their own risk. Access ends on 31st July 2019.
